

Aperfield Montessori Trust Application for scholarship

The Aperfield Montessori Trust offers assistance to successful applicants to complete a Montessori early childhood programme delivered by Te Rito Maioha Early Childhood New Zealand (**Programme**). The Programme is designed to provide early childhood educators and other interested education professionals, education in the Montessori philosophy, curriculum and methods of teaching and learning ('the Montessori Method')

Qualification

Students completing the Programme will gain the following qualification: New Zealand Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care – Te tohu Pokairua Matauranga Kohungahunga Manaaki (level 5)

Prerequisites

Before applying for the Scholarship, the applicant must confirm the following;

- That he/she is a New Zealand citizen or New Zealand permanent resident (a copy of the passport and evidence of residency status must accompany the application).
- That he/she has enrolled and been accepted by Te Rito Maioha Early Childhood New Zealand to undertake a course of study towards the *New Zealand Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care Te tohu Pokairua Matauranga Kohungahunga (Level 5),* having met the criteria for enrolment.
- That he/she has not received and is not eligible for any other grants or scholarships e.g. TEACHNZ scholarships, Government initiatives.
- That he/she is in a paid or voluntary role in a **New Zealand Montessori preschool.** Evidence supporting this must accompany the application.

Eligibility criteria

Trustees will consider a number of factors when assessing an application. The covering letter that accompanies your application for the scholarship must include the following.

- Why you want to study Montessori
- What you will do after you complete the Programme
- Details of any current or previous involvement with Montessori preschools
- How you have demonstrated or shown interest in the Montessori method of education including any research or readings
- Any financial constraints you might have and how the scholarship will help with your current situation
- Any charitable work which you have completed
- Any outside interests, cultural issues, impairment, condition or disability that you would like the Trustees to consider
- Two referee reports are required. One referee must be a professional leader or colleague

<u>Scholarships must be received by the closing date January 10th and for the mid-year intake July 2nd</u> <u>Late applications will not be accepted</u>.

Scholarship Process

The Aperfield Montessori Trustees will assess all applications based on the prerequisites and eligibility criteria as listed above. Applicants will be informed whether or not the application for scholarship is successful, in writing on or before 3 February and for the mid-year intake 23 July of each academic year. Decisions are at the absolute discretion of the Aperfield Montessori Trustees and are final and binding.

On successful completion of the Programme the applicant will have to forward to the Administrator documentation showing evidence of successful completion of the Programme together with any receipts for accommodation and travel relating to attendance at the "Workshop" (being the five day NZ Diploma in ECE (Aperfield Montessori) block course working with materials covering Practical Life, Sensorial Activities and curriculum areas including mathematics, language, biology and geography) (if applicable). The Aperfield Montessori administrator, will reimburse students up to a maximum of \$3,000.00 for course fees in relation to the Programme. An additional reimbursement for 50% of the costs of flights and accommodation (reasonably incurred) of up to \$1,000.00 relating to attendance at the Workshop can be claimed at the same time. (Receipts are required). Payment will be made within 30 days of the Aperfield Montessori administrator receiving satisfactory evidence and receipts.

Email applications should be sent to the <u>administrator@aperfield-montessori.co.nz</u> before 10th January and 2nd July in each academic year. No applications will be considered after the closing date.
