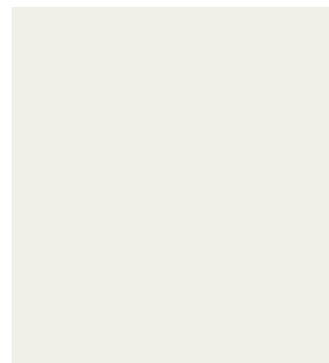


Student ID and Verification of Identity Form

If you are selected for a Te Rito Maioha programme, your photo will be scanned for your ID card and then placed on file. ID cards will also be issued once payment of fees and your enrolment documentation has been confirmed. Replacement ID cards can be issued but will incur a replacement fee.

A recent photograph of you is required (no older than 12 months).
The photograph must

- Be identical to passport photograph dimensions (35mm x 45mm)
- Not be a photocopy
- Not be more than 12 months old
- Be a full, front view of your head, face and shoulders
- Be clean and well lit, against a plain or light-coloured background

Verification of Identity

As of 1 July 2015 it is now a legal requirement that you supply **two** forms of identification as part of the application process for teacher education qualifications. The following forms are acceptable.

Establishing that the identity exists:

You must supply a **verified copy** of **one** of the documents below:

- New Zealand Birth Certificate issued on or after 1 January 1998 carrying a unique identification number
- New Zealand Passport
- Overseas passport (must include relevant visa/residency permit)
- New Zealand Emergency travel document
- New Zealand refugee travel document
- New Zealand certificate of identity (issued under the Passports Act 1992 to non-NZ citizens who cannot obtain a passport from their country of origin)
- New Zealand certificate of identity (issued under Immigration Act 1987 to people who have refugee status)
- New Zealand citizenship certificate.

Establishing that the identity is a living identity and that the person presenting uses the identity in the community.

You must also supply a **verified copy** of **one** of the documents below:

- New Zealand Driver's licence
- 18+ Card
- Community services card
- NZ student photo identification card – from another tertiary institution
- NZ employee photo identification card
- NZ electoral roll record
- Inland revenue number
- NZ issued utility bill, issued not more than six months earlier.

What is a verified copy?

A verified copy is a photocopy of your original document signed as being a true and accurate copy by a Justice of the Peace (JP), solicitor, church minister, kaumātua, Police officer, school principal, Member of Parliament or Te Rito Maioha teaching staff member.
